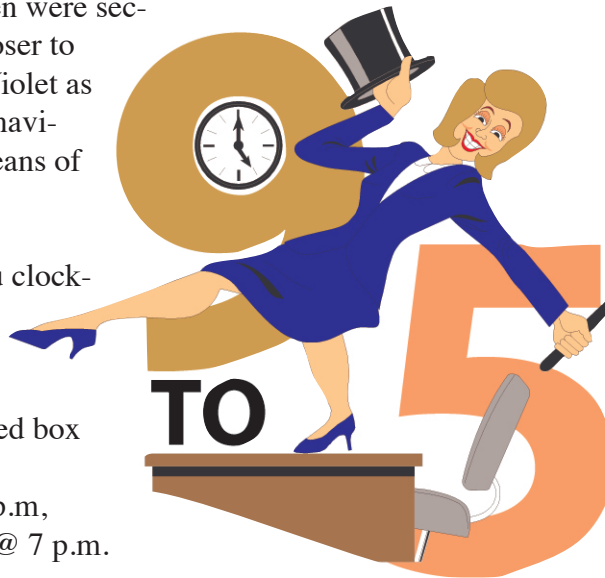
Dolly Parton's hit song and film, "9 to 5" is now the hit musical comedy and it's coming to the Apple Shed!

Raintree Arts Council Offered Many Activities To Our Communities This Past Year

- Spring brought Eagle Days in January with hundreds of visitors watching over 200 eagles at the Clarksville water front. In April, ENCORE - our annual fund-raiser provided music, fun and food to guests.
- In June the 28th annual Missouri State Chili Cook-Off offered the large crowd fabulous salsa and chili, warm, sunny weather, and great music from the Original Chili Cook-Off Band. The ‘Classy Classic Ladies’ concert by Debbie Ingram, Raintree Art Council Board Member, delighted attendees with country music at Bowling Green High School Auditorium in July.
- Fall was especially busy with performances of musical and theatre themes, and visual arts. The Changelings, Raintree’s theatre group, made up of local actors and volunteers, presented “Comedy of Errors” to approximately 100 patrons over two weekends at the Clarksville riverfront park. September also featured Cornet Chop Suey jazz band with two concerts at local schools for Bowling Green and Louisiana students with a concert at the Apple Shed the following weekend.
- October featured the visual arts with two annual shows. Our 48th Annual Applefest Art Show included 33 adult entries, with 120 works, and 318 student entries. The show was open both days during Applefest and hundreds of people stopped by to view the art. We estimate we reached over 600 community members with this show. The Colorfest Youth Art Show was sponsored by Peoples Bank & Trust. This art show took place during Louisiana’s Colorfest and had a total of 390 entries from area students. Artwork entries were from students in Louisiana, Clopton, Bowling Green, Elsberry, and Logan Private Studio and were viewed by over 300 visitors.
- The year wrapped up with “Christmas Through the Years” in December. Donna Grote, Raintree Art Council Board Member, shared her talents with a packed audience. She and her talented friends entertained crowds with familiar and not-so-familiar Christmas tunes to start off the holiday season.

We also added a new board member in 2022! January brings the beginning of a new year and new events. In addition to our best-loved events, we will

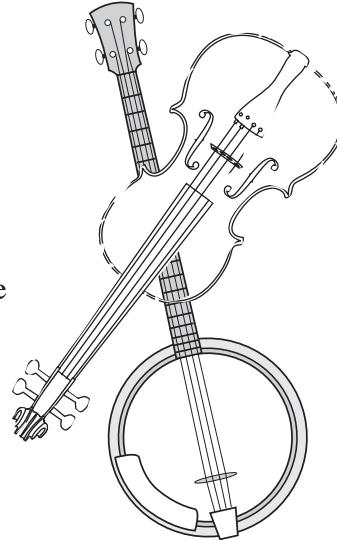
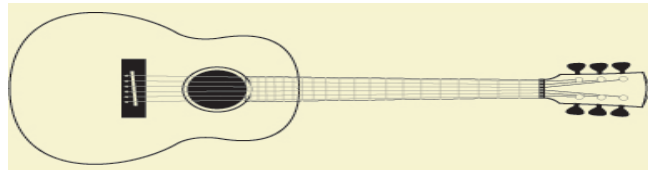
have several new performances and events that you will not want to miss.
